#### **OVERVIEW for Tuesday 23 September 2025- Day 2 at the State Fire Academy:**

 $09:15 \rightarrow 17:00$ 

- For this day, you will be supplied with a variety of domestic appliances
- You will work in syndicates to deconstruct the appliances and produce wiring diagrams of each
- You will then defeat any safety devices, or bypass them in order to allow them to fail (ignite)
- You will then reconstruct the appliances
- Each syndicates will exchange their appliances and wiring diagrams with the other syndicates
- The appliances will be energised and if successfully prepared, should ignite
- As a syndicate you will need to determine what occurred within the appliance to make it fail
- During the day, several practical activities will be carried out in parallel, including small scale burn cells and the use of calcination evaluation within them.
- Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear.
